"43" "File Cleanup Procedure Fails at End of Year" "General"

This problem was discovered during the testing of the SWIT 5.0 on the Intel platform. But, it also exists on the SPARC SWIT.

The problem involves the script execution of SWIT_Init. The script is written to delete tranx and tranr files that reflect a julian date 10 days less than system's current julian date from the transtp and savedir directory. When the system reaches the end of the year, all files that exist from the last 10 days of the previous year do not delete themselves when the SWIT_Init script is executed. If the current julian date is 004, it thinks that any file with a julian date of 358 is greater than the current date; therefore not deleting this file.

"98" "6249-TDAS (after installation of DTOD)" "General"

URGENT The capturing of the items retrieved from DTOD has not been incorporated into TDAS, so if you archive, you cannot process any shipments. No workaround

"135" "6449-TRANSACTIONS SENT FROM QNAK HAVE NOT ARRIVED AT QXAK" "General"

Shipments being processed at the PPPO are not being transferred to the PPSO.

"138" "6377-adding users" "General"

URGENT Adding users through TADMIN. After adding the user 'bert' and 'robert', then TA realized 'bert' had the wrong menu options, attempted to 'Update' his menus through 'TADMIN', did not accept updates. Determine 'robert' was deleted from the /etc/passwd file and 'bert' was incorrectly formatted. No workaround

"209" "5921-savedir and mtmcmmsg directories" "General"

ROUTINE SAVEDIR AND MTMCMMSG DIRECTORIES 1-Files are not being deleted from the user/spool/ uucppublic directories, and are taking up space. 2-PPSOs with stand alone PPPO's OTRAN files are not clearing out. 3-Need to develop a method of saving tranX files in usr/spool/uucppublic/savedir until they are successfully transmitted. 4-In usr/spool/uucppublic/savewhist dir: Files with a Julian date extension of 36' are not being removed/ cleaned up by the software. 5-The tranfiles in /usr/spool/uucppublic and sub directories should be kept on the system for 5 days. 1-Contact Hotline for specifics 2-Contact Hotline for specifics 3-No Workaround, Contact Hotline for specifics 4-No Workaround, Contact Hotline for specifics 5-No Workaround

"211" "5968-REJECTS IN MAIL-REMOTE SHIPMENTS" "General"

ROUTINE REJECTS IN MAIL FROM REMOTE SHIPMENTS -Rejects in admin mail when user did two remotes to two different GBLOCs, and the destination was the user's GBLOC. Remote shipments returned on the same day from two different sites with same shipment No. are rejected. No Workaround.

"215" "6012-MUL-NTS MUL P/U FAILS-ADDITIONAL P/U RATE NOT IN SYSTEM"

ROUTINE HAWAII SITE unable to do NTS multiple pickups because rates for alternate PU are contained in item 105A (Dometic_addl_service_item table) which does not apply to OCONUS. Contact Hotline for assistance. No Workaround.

"220" "6088-MULTIPLE-EDRECORD" "General"

ROUTINE EDRECORD 1-For shipments with more than one delivery, if you cancel a delivery date, it cancels all delivery records. 2-Unable to cancel or change the delivery date for a DPM shipment. 1-No Workaround 2-No Workaround

"224" "6192-Incorrect processing of QA Remarks data at all TOPS sites." "General"

ROUTINE QA REMARKS DATA - Due to a format problem with this transmission process, the QA remarks data is not being sent between sites. No Workaround

"227" "6217-Transmissions: Receiving incomplete data from certain bases"

"General"

URGENT DATA TRANSMISSIONS - Not all data transmissions are being received by TOPS sites, causing destination PPSOs to have to create new shipment information. Software modification required to alter format of data transmissions No Workaround

"229" "6241-TDAS - Defragmenting the Database" "General"

ROUTINE Defragmenting the Database - When defragmenting the database, tables are defragged and it also fragments the tablespace. It should not fragment tablespace. No workaround

"232" "6258-GBLOC Description" "General"

ROUTINE GBLOC Description - Since DTOD all cities located in each county is identified through DTOD. Need to expand the column width to identify which part of each county is owned by different AORs. No workaround

"248" "6392-Processing Delete Records for Intl_dpm_zone_description" "General"

ROUTINE Processing Delete Records for Intl_dpm_zone_description Table. Currently the inserts are processing, but the deletes are not, site receives an error message. No workaround

"250" "6394-IVR identify new Enhancements from IDP 9.X." "General"

URGENT IVR ability to identify New Enhancements from IDP 9.X. System does not identify any OTO/MOTO/BOTO, SIT at Origin, Long Delivery in SIT shipments No workaround

"253" "6405-SF1203" "General"

The system does not print data on the SF1203 that is required by the DTR, specifically: "SIT NOT TO EXCEED 90 DAYS IS AUTHORIZED". This should be fixed ASAP.

"259" "6419-Password Change at LOGIN" "General"

URGENT Password change at LOGIN. User receives msg to update their password. When attempting to change password, the sequence of changing their password is incorrect. No workaround

"260" "6422-TDAS" "General"

ROUTINE TDAS De-Archiving process. Program provides running display of percent complete. It may display less or over 100%. Should display 100%. No Workaround

"261" "6423-TDAS" "General"

ROUTINE TDAS (Item 2). Completion of De-Archiving process, user hits (Return) key, it moves to the DeArchive submenu. Selection Option #2, it returns user to the same menu. No workaround

"262" "6424-TDAS" "General"

ROUTINE TDAS (Item 3). Completion of De-Archiving process, user hits (Return) key, it moves to the DeArchive submenu. Selection Option #3 EXIT, returns user to the same menu. The second attempt of entering '4', the program exits as expected.

"265" "6443-TOPS Remote vs. Network Printers" "General"

ROUTINE TOPS Remote Printers. Since IDP 8.2/ICP8.2.1 many TOPS sites block inbound TCP/IP traffic to the default print server port 9100, a 'raw' TCP socket on the new Lexmark Optra T610 printer. No workaround.
