SUBJECT: TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ADVISORY (TMA) MESSAGE 03-01,
GUIDANCE ON UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE (USDA)
PROGRAM TO PREVENT THE SPREAD OF GYPSY MOTH

1. REFERENCE:

2. THIS MESSAGE CANCELS TMA 1-99, SAB, AND PROVIDES THE LATEST GUIDANCE ON THE GYPSY MOTH PROGRAM PROCEDURES, SERVICE MEMBER INSPECTION AND CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS, THE PROCEDURES TO BE FOLLOWED BY THE PPPO/PPSO/PORTS, AND A LIST OF THE REGULATED AREAS REQUIRING A CERTIFICATE OF INSPECTION PRIOR TO MOVEMENT. BECAUSE OF CHANGES IN PROCEDURES AND ADDITIONS TO THE 'QUARANTINE' AREAS, ALL PPSO/PPPO/PORT PERSONNEL SHOULD CAREFULLY REVIEW THIS MESSAGE.

3. THE ANIMAL AND PLANT HEALTH INSPECTION SERVICE (APHIS) OF THE USDA HAS PLACED ADDITIONAL STATES/COUNTIES TO ITS LISTING OF 'QUARANTINED' AREAS. SERVICE MEMBERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ENSURING ALL OUTDOOR HOUSEHOLD ARTICLES (OHA) THAT HAVE BEEN KEPT OUTSIDE THE HOME, SUCH AS AWNINGS, BARBECUE GRILLS, BICYCLES, BOATS, DOG HOUSES, GARBAGE CANS, GARDEN TOOLS, LAWN MOWERS, OUTDOOR FURNITURE, AND TOYS, WHICH ARE MOVED FROM

'QUARANTINED' AREAS, ARE ACCOMPANIED BY EITHER A CERTIFICATE OF INSPECTION ISSUED BY A QUALIFIED CERTIFIED APPLICATOR (QCA) OR BY AN OHA DOCUMENT COMPLETED BY THE OWNER.

4. THE USDA HAS THE AUTHORITY TO IMPOSE CIVIL PENALTIES AGAINST INDIVIDUAL OWNERS AND CARRIERS FOUND TO BE MOVING OHA THAT HARBOR LIFE FORMS OF THE GYPSY MOTH. IT IS VERY IMPORTANT THAT COUNSELORS BECOME FAMILIAR WITH THIS TMA TO ENSURE MEMBERS MOVING OUT OF A STATE/COUNTY DESIGNATED AS A GYPSY MOTH 'QUARANTINED' AREA ARE PROPERLY COUNSELED AS TO WHICH SHIPMENTS WILL BE AFFECTED, CARRIER ACCEPTANCE OF SHIPMENTS, REIMBURSABLE COSTS, AND THE MEMBER'S RESPONSIBILITY TO OBTAIN AND PROVIDE A CERTIFICATE OF INSPECTION TO THE CARRIER.

5. ALL SHIPMENTS (DOMESTIC, INTERNATIONAL, NONTEMPORARY STORAGE (NTS), OR STORAGE-IN-TRANSIT (SIT) AT ORIGIN) PICKED UP IN A 'QUARANTINED' AREA MUST BE INSPECTED PRIOR TO MOVEMENT WITH ONE EXCEPTION. A LOCAL MOVE PICKED UP IN A 'QUARANTINED' AREA, TRANSITING ONLY 'QUARANTINED' AREAS EN ROUTE, AND DELIVERED TO A 'QUARANTINED' AREA IS EXEMPT FROM AN INSPECTION.

6. MEMBERS MAY HIRE (AT THE MEMBER'S EXPENSE) PROFESSIONAL COMPANIES APPROVED BY THE USDA TO INSPECT AND, IF NECESSARY, TREAT THEIR PROPERTY PRIOR TO PICKUP. THE COMPANY PERFORMING THE INSPECTION WILL FURNISH THE MEMBER WITH A CERTIFICATE DECLARING THE PROPERTY FREE OF ALL FORMS OF THE GYPSY MOTH. NAMES OF QCAS AND PLANT REGULATORY OFFICIALS FOR THE STATES AND TERRITORIES OF THE US ARE AVAILABLE FROM THE REGIONAL OFFICES OF APHIS OR FROM APHIS-PPQ, INVASIVE SPECIES AND PEST MANAGEMENT, 4700 RIVER ROAD, UNIT 134, SUITE 4C36, RIVERDALE, MD 20737, TELEPHONE (301) 734-5705. MEMBERS CHOOSING TO SELF-INSPECT AND, IF NECESSARY, TREAT THEIR OWN PROPERTY SHOULD OBTAIN THE USDA 'DON'T MOVE GYPSY MOTHS' PAMPHLET, WHICH MAY BE FOUND IN REF WEB SITE. THIS PAMPHLET PROVIDES INFORMATION ON HOW TO INSPECT, IDENTIFY, AND DISPOSE OF GYPSY MOTHS AND GYPSY MOTH LARVAE. IT ALSO CONTAINS A SELF-INSPECTION CHECKLIST THAT MAY BE USED TO VERIFY A MEMBER'S PROPERTY HAS BEEN INSPECTED. THE CHECKLIST MUST BE PROPERLY DATED AND SIGNED. IF MEMBERS SELF-INSPECT AND DO NOT USE THE SELF-INSPECTION CHECKLIST, THEY MUST PREPARE A WRITTEN STATEMENT STATING THEY HAVE INSPECTED THEIR OHA AND EITHER FOUND THEM TO BE FREE OF GYPSY MOTH LARVAE OR IF EGGS ARE FOUND, THEY WERE REMOVED AND DESTROYED.

7. MEMBERS CHOOSING TO SELF-INSPECT THEIR OWN PROPERTY WILL BE SUBJECT TO FINES IF A LATER INSPECTION REVEALS LIFE STAGES OF THE GYPSY MOTH TO BE PRESENT. INSPECTION/TREATMENTS MUST BE

PERFORMED NO MORE THAN 5 DAYS PRIOR TO THE DATE OF PICK-UP DURING THE MONTHS OF APRIL THROUGH AUGUST OR 14 DAYS PRIOR TO PICK-UP DURING THE MONTHS OF SEPTEMBER THROUGH MARCH. SINCE PENALTIES/FINES IMPOSED BY USDA AND/OR CERTAIN STATES ARE CONSIDERABLE WHEN A SHIPMENT FAILS AN INSPECTION EN ROUTE OR AT DESTINATION, MEMBERS SHOULD BE HIGHLY ENCOURAGED TO HAVE THEIR PROPERTY PROFESSIONALLY INSPECTED TO AVOID COSTLY FINES, DELAYS AND INCONVENIENCE.

8. THE MILITARY SERVICES ADVISE THAT THE COST OF INSPECTION FOR GYPSY MOTHS IS A REIMBURSEABLE EXPENSE FOR BOTH UNIFORMED AND CIVILIAN MEMBERS OF DOD. IN ADDITION, THE COST OF TREATMENT (IF NECESSARY) MAY BE REIMBURSABLE. ANY QUESTIONS ON REIMBURSEMENT SHOULD BE DIRECTED THROUGH YOUR MACOMS/MAJCOMS TO THE APPROPRIATE MILITARY SERVICE HQS.

9. CARRIERS SHOULD ENSURE THAT A CERTIFICATE OF INSPECTION IS PROVIDED ON ALL SHIPMENTS MOVING OUT OF "QUARANTINED" AREAS. CARRIERS HAVE THE RIGHT TO REFUSE A SHIPMENT IF THE MEMBER DOES NOT PROVIDE A CERTIFICATE FROM A CERTIFIED INSPECTOR OR AN OHA DOCUMENT COMPLETED BY THE MEMBER AFFIRMING THAT THE PROPERTY IS FREE OF ALL FORMS OF GYPSY MOTH. THE CARRIER IS RESPONSIBLE FOR ENSURING THE CERTIFICATE OR OHA DOCUMENT REMAINS WITH THE SHIPMENT AT ALL TIMES DURING MOVEMENT.

10. SHIPMENTS PLACED IN NTS OR SIT AT ORIGIN REQUIRE THE FOLLOWING ACTIONS:

(A) SHIPMENTS PICKED UP IN "QUARANTINED" AREAS AND PLACED IN NTS OR SIT AT ORIGIN REQUIRE A CERTIFICATE OF INSPECTION AT TIME OF PICK-UP. THE MEMBER IS REQUIRED TO PROVIDE THE CERTIFICATE TO THE PPSO/PPPO. THE PPSO/PPPO WILL PLACE THE INSPECTION CERTIFICATE IN THE MEMBER'S NTS OR OUTBOUND SHIPMENT FILE. AT THE TIME OF SHIPMENT FROM NTS OR ORIGIN SIT, THE PPGBL MUST BE ANNOTATED WITH THE DATE THE SHIPMENT WAS PLACED IN STORAGE AND THE ORIGINAL CERTIFICATE OF INSPECTION MUST BE ATTACHED TO THE PPGBL. NO RECERTIFICATION OF INSPECTION IS REQUIRED AT THE TIME OF SHIPMENT FROM STORAGE.

(B) SHIPMENTS MOVING FROM A "QUARANTINED" AREA THAT WERE PLACED IN NTS OR ORIGIN SIT PRIOR TO THAT AREA BEING DESIGNATED AS A "QUARANTINED" AREA WILL NOT REQUIRE A CERTIFICATE OF INSPECTION UPON RELEASE FROM STORAGE. THESE SHIPMENTS WILL NOT BE SUBJECT TO FINES IF AN INSPECTION AT A LATER DATE REVEALS THE PRESENCE OF GYPSY MOTHS, PROVIDED THE PPGBL MOVING THE SHIPMENT FROM STORAGE CONTAINS THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT: "THIS

SHIPMENT WAS ORIGINALLY PLACED IN (NONTEMPORARY STORAGE OR SIT AT ORIGIN) ON (ORIGINAL PICK-UP DATE), WHICH WAS PRIOR TO THE DESIGNATION OF (ORIGIN CITY, COUNTY & STATE) AS A 'QUARANTINED' AREA FOR GYPSY MOTHS.'

(C) SHIPMENTS GOING INTO NTS OR SIT AT ORIGIN THAT WERE PICKED UP AT A RESIDENCE IN AN AREA NOT DESIGNATED AS A 'QUARANTINED' AREA, BUT ARE PLACED IN NTS OR SIT AT ORIGIN IN A 'QUARANTINED' AREA WILL NOT REQUIRE A CERTIFICATE UPON RELEASE FROM STORAGE. THESE SHIPMENTS WILL NOT BE SUBJECT TO FINES IF AN INSPECTION AT A LATER DATE REVEALS THE PRESENCE OF GYPSY MOTHS, PROVIDED THE PPGBL MOVING THE SHIPMENT FROM STORAGE CONTAINS THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT: 'THIS SHIPMENT WAS PICKED UP FROM RESIDENCE IN (CITY, COUNTY, & STATE) BUT WAS PLACED IN (NONTEMPORARY STORAGE OR SIT AT ORIGIN) IN (CITY, COUNTY, & STATE), A 'QUARANTINED' AREA FOR GYPSY MOTH.

(D) FOR SITUATIONS INDICATED IN PARAS 10(A) AND 10(B) ABOVE, FACILITIES LOCATED IN 'QUARANTINED' AREAS ARE REQUIRED TO PROVIDE A STATEMENT ON COMPANY LETTERHEAD ATTESTING TO ONE OF THE FOLLOWING:

(1) THE STORAGE PREMISES ARE GYPSY MOTH-FREE AND POSES NO THREAT OF INFESTATION;

(2) THE CONTAINER WAS IMPERVIOUS TO GYPSY MOTHS; THUS, THE OHA WAS NOT VULNERABLE TO GYPSY MOTH INFESTATION; OR

(3) THE CONTAINER WAS NOT IN THE REGULATED AREA DURING THE PERIOD OF THE GYPSY MOTH LIFE CYCLE (APRIL THROUGH JUNE) WHEN IT WAS CAPABLE OF INFESTING THE SHIPMENT.

11. PPPOS LOCATED OUTSIDE A 'QUARANTINED' AREA AND PREPARING A MAIL-IN APPLICATION FOR A SHIPMENT TO BE PICKED UP WITHIN A 'QUARANTINED' AREA SHOULD COUNSEL THE MEMBER ON THE GYPSY MOTH PROGRAM. DD FORM 1299 SHOULD STATE THAT THE MEMBER WAS COUNSELED ON THE GYPSY MOTH PROGRAM AND SHOULD INCLUDE ANY INSTRUCTIONS FROM THE MEMBER (I.E., WHO TO CONTACT (SPOUSE/AGENT) IF A GYPSY MOTH INSPECTION IS REQUIRED). SHOULD THE MEMBER SPECIFICALLY ASK WHETHER THE PICK-UP ADDRESS IS WITHIN A 'QUARANTINED' AREA, THE PPPO SHOULD CONTACT THE RESPONSIBLE PPSO FOR THIS INFORMATION, PRIOR TO COMPLETING THE APPLICATION.

12. WHEN PPSOS THAT ARE WITHIN OR HAVE RESPONSIBILITY IN 'QUARANTINED' AREAS RECEIVE MAIL-IN APPLICATIONS, THEY MUST

DETERMINE IF THE ACTUAL PICK-UP POINT IS WITHIN A ‘QUARANTINED’ AREA AND THEN TAKE THE APPROPRIATE ACTION (I.E., FOLLOW THE MEMBER’S INSTRUCTIONS ON THE DD FORM 1299) OR MAKE EVERY EFFORT TO CONTACT THE MEMBER’S SPOUSE/AGENT WHEN THE SHIPMENT IS TO BE PICKED UP FROM A RESIDENCE, TO ENSURE THE PROPER CERTIFICATE IS OBTAINED PRIOR TO PICK-UP OF THE PROPERTY.

13. IN ADDITION TO THE ABOVE REQUIREMENTS, THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA HAS IMPLEMENTED STRICT REQUIREMENTS ON SHIPMENTS ENTERING CALIFORNIA. ALL SHIPMENTS ORIGINATING FROM ‘QUARANTINED’ AREAS WITH DESTINATIONS IN CALIFORNIA MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A CERTIFICATE OF INSPECTION AND ARE SUBJECT TO INSPECTION AT THE TIME OF DELIVERY OR SHORTLY THEREAFTER. (NOTE: EXPORT SHIPMENTS ARE NOT SUBJECT TO THESE INSPECTIONS, PROVIDED THE FINAL DESTINATION OF THE SHIPMENT, TO INCLUDE CITY/COUNTY, IS CLEARLY SPELLED OUT ON THE PPGBL AND OTHER SHIPPING DOCUMENTS. SHIPMENTS FROM ‘QUARANTINED’ AREAS THAT ARRIVE WITHOUT THIS CERTIFICATE WILL RESULT IN THE ISSUANCE OF A MISDEMEANOR CITATION TO BOTH THE CARRIER AND THE DRIVER AND MAY DELAY THE ONWARD MOVEMENT OF THE SHIPMENT TO DESTINATION. IT IS EXTREMELY IMPORTANT THAT THE MEMBER BE THOROUGHLY COUNSELED AND UNDERSTANDS THESE REQUIREMENTS, AS ANY INDIVIDUAL WHOSE NEGLIGENCE CAUSES AN INFESTATION OF GYPSY MOTHS IN CALIFORNIA MAY BE SUBJECT TO THE COST OF ERADICATION OF THE INFESTATION.

14. WHILE THE ABOVE INSTRUCTIONS ARE QUITE LENGTHY, IT IS IMPORTANT THAT ALL PPSOS/PPPOS BECOME FAMILIAR WITH THIS INFORMATION SO THEY CAN PROPERLY COUNSEL MEMBERS ON THEIR RESPONSIBILITIES WHEN MOVING PERSONAL PROPERTY FROM AREAS DESIGNATED AS ‘QUARANTINED’ AREAS FOR GYPSY MOTHS.
